Area #4: Same as for Area #1, above.

Tract D (see Deer Hollow Work Area Map): Weed whack and rake as needed to maintain a neat appearance.

*Additionally, mow or weed whack along Edgewood Drive guard rail as needed in order to maintain a neat appearance. (This area is occasionally mowed by Jefferson County, but not frequently enough to maintain a neat appearance throughout the summer.)
